Possessing your Possessions

- Possessions (belongings, assets, property) in this sense are the Promises of God e.g.
 - ✓ Land (Gen 48:4; Ps 2:8; Deut 11:24;)
 - ✓ Divine Healing (Exo 23:25)
 - ✓ Long Life (Ps91:16; 1 Chro29:28)
 - ✓ Wisdom (James 1:5)
 - ✓ Prosperity (Malachi 3:10–12)
 - ✓ Life and Godliness – good things (Pro 28:10; 2Peter 1:3)
 - ✓ etc

Possessing Your Possessions – 4 things to do

- **Think Big**
- **Have Faith**
- **Love God**
- **Act Big**

Possessing your Possessions - Think Big

- God is a Big God (Bigger than the Biggest)
- God gives Big, great, wonderful things and His promises are yes and Amen (II Corint. 1:20)
- God is everything Good (Healer, Redeemer, Deliverer, Advocate, Refuge, Helper etc)
- Don't limit God, receive every bit of His promise concerning different aspects of your life

Possessing your Possessions - Have Faith

- Believe what God says concerning you.
- If He says it, He will do it
- He did it for others, HE will also do it for you
- Without faith it is impossible to please God (Hebs 11:1, 6)
- Faith sees the invisible, believes the incredible, & receives the impossible

Possessing Your Possessions - Love God

- Love God and Keep His commandments
- Deuteronomy 7:9

Know therefore that the LORD thy **God**, He is **God**, the faithful **God**, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that **love** him and keep his **commandments** to a thousand generations;
- Be submissive to His instructions
- Live in holiness (Obadiah 1:17)

Possessing your Possessions - Act Big

- To claim His Promises, you need to take actions (and often times big steps) and there are conditions
 - Holiness
 - Sacrifice (money, time, resources etc)
 - Faith and works
 - Prayers
- Possessing involves action
(James 2:18, 20, 26)

Case study of Joshua and Caleb

- Numbers 13
- Joshua 14
- Joshua and Caleb saw and believed that they could possess the land God promised and at the age of 85 years, Caleb possessed His possession.
